Support your student at the Festival Concert. Tickets will be available at the door: \$6.00 (adults) and \$4.00 (students/seniors).

Final Concert

The final concert is at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 24 at Pacific University in the Athletic Center (PAC). Tickets are \$6 (adults) and \$4 (students/seniors) and are available in the Music in May office or at the door. Students are released at the end of the concert. Recordings will be available. Forms can be turned in at the recording table at the final concert, or mailed in to the recording agency by mid-June.

Registration

When you arrive, go directly to McCormick Hall, where you will check in and receive your nametag/meal pass, room assignment, handbook, T-shirt and other important information. Plan to arrive early enough to register, get settled in your dorm room, and be on time for the Welcome / Orientation at 1:00pm in the Taylor-Meade Auditorium. A campus map will be in your music packet.

Housing and Meals

Housing is provided for Thursday and Friday nights only, except for those who have made reservations and paid *in advance* for Wednesday and/or Saturday night. If you arrive before Thursday morning, and no advance arrangements have been made, you cannot be housed on campus.

Meals are included from Thursday dinner (evening) through Saturday noon, and are provided for student participants only. They are served in the University Center dining area at times shown. Students must clear their tray after each meal.

Rules

Music in May rules are for the safety of everyone, as well as the integrity of the festival. Violations may result in a student being sent home at his or her own expense.

- Students, parents and school officials should understand that Pacific University and *Music in May* will accept no liability for students during the festival.
- Students may not go beyond a two-block radius of campus for any reason. If you must leave the two block radius, you must send or bring *written permission* from your parent or high school director to the Music in May Office, Taylor-Meade 208. After the final concert, the festival is concluded and students are released.
- Attendance at all rehearsals is mandatory. Attendance is taken at the *beginning* of the rehearsal, so be on time!
- Students are expected to be prompt at rehearsals, lessons, meals, and curfews. Please notify your mentor if, *for any reason whatsoever*, you are not able to abide by the printed schedule.
- Curfew hours are strictly enforced. Mentors have been advised to notify the Music in May Director of violations.
- Each student will be issued dorm and room keys at check-in. There will be a \$75 charge for lost keys.
- Don't lose your nametag / meal pass. Replacement fee is \$1.
- Use of tobacco products, alcohol or drugs of any kind is strictly prohibited during the festival. If a student requires prescription medication, specific information must be provided on the student's medical information form or in writing, signed by a parent/guardian.
- No men beyond main lounges of women's dorms; no women beyond the main lounge in the men's dorm at any time.
- All students must evacuate the residence hall if a fire alarm is sounded. Tampering with or misuse of fire and safety equipment, including fire alarms, fire extinguishers, smoke alarms and other safety equipment is a criminal offense and may result in a fine and/or disciplinary action.
- Student-caused damages to furniture, rooms, and public areas at Pacific University will be charged to the responsible party. All damages will be charged at replacement cost.
- Conduct is expected to be above criticism. If an incident requiring disciplinary action should arise, the parents and principal of the student's school will be notified, and the student may be asked to leave.

What to Bring

___ Your Instrument

Don't forget valve oil, cork grease, mutes, extra reeds, spare strings, etc., in case of emergency.

___ Your Music

Check twice to make sure it's all there before you leave home!

___ Folding Music Stand

(band members only)

___ A Pencil

With eraser would be nice. Put it in the envelope with your music so you're ready for the first rehearsal.

___ Clothes

For rehearsals, you will wear casual clothes. For the concert, all performers will wear white shirts / blouses and dark (black preferred) pants / skirts (no short skirts). Choir members need comfortable shoes!

___ Sleeping Bag & Pillow, Towel, Soap, Alarm Clock, Personal Items

The heat will not be on in the dorms - be sure to bring warm PJs and bedding, as nights can be cool.

___ For Fun

Frisbee, cards, etc. (Please note that skateboards and rollerblades are prohibited on campus - please don't bring them.)

___ Money

Bring only enough for your expenses on the trip to and from Pacific and for vending machine snacks. Music in May and Pacific University are not responsible for lost or stolen valuables. It's best not to bring any more than absolutely necessary, and to exercise caution with your cash and personal belongings.

___ Personal Belongings

Mark your belongings with your name - each year we have a number of lost/found items we're unable to return to the owner!
