APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID

Pacific University offers a comprehensive financial aid program containing academic merit scholarships and a full range of federal, state and university grants, loans and work opportunities. Financing your education is a partnership between you, your family and this University, and you are expected to be an active and contributing participant. To apply for aid, complete the Financial Aid and Scholarship sections below. To be considered for state or federal aid, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. You can find this application on the web at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

To avoid delay or error, it is particularly important to do the following:

- Submit the Pacific University Application for Admission to the Office of Admissions. Offers of assistance are made only after a decision of admission to the University has been made.
- List Pacific University's Title IV Code number (003212) when completing the FAFSA.
- If you would like to provide the Financial Aid Office with any additional information detailing unique circumstances, you are welcome to submit letters along with other documentation. Be sure all correspondence contains your full name and social security number.

You may file your FAFSA any time after January 1. For maximum aid consideration, apply before February 15. Remember, you may estimate income information when completing the FAFSA if actual income information is not available in January.

SCHOLARSHIPS

We automatically consider all applicants for merit-based awards (\$7,500 to \$12,000 for freshmen and \$6,000 to \$9,000 for transfer students) based on GPA and SAT I/ACT scores.

Competitive scholarships are offered in the fields of music (vocal and instrumental) and Forensics (speech/debate). We also offer Tom McCall scholarships to students interested in political science, law or business.

TYPES OF ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

You will be considered for academic merit scholarships offered by Pacific regardless of financial need. If you choose to apply for further assistance and show you have eligibility for other types of aid, you may receive one or a combination of the following:

- Federal Work-Study
- Federal Pell Grant
- Federal Perkins Loan
- Pacific Work-Study
- Pacific Grant
- Federal Direct Stafford Loan (subsidized or unsubsidized)
- Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant
- Federal Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS)
- Pacific Talent Award or Endowed Scholarship
- Oregon State Need Grant

Federal regulations often require parents and students to provide copies of their federal income tax returns to colleges where they apply for aid. Be sure to have copies of these items readily available and respond promptly to inquiries from the University for additional information.

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS

- Alumni Scholarship

If you are the dependent of a Pacific Alumnus, you may be eligible for up to \$500 in additional funds.

- United Church of Christ Scholarship

If you are a dependent of an active UCC minister or are a member of the UCC Church, you may be eligible for additional funds.

- Pacific Pacesetters Competition

Freshman students with qualifying SAT I and/or ACT scores may be eligible to compete for scholarships ranging from \$1,000 - \$3,000 per year for up to four years.

- Tom McCall Scholarship

This unique scholarship honors the work and service of former Oregon Governor Tom McCall. Admitted students showing special interest in public affairs can receive up to \$2,000.

- Forensics Scholarships

For students interested in joining the Pacific Forensics Team, scholarships are available based on both past accomplishments and future potential in speech and debate. Awards range from \$500 to \$2,500.

- Music Scholarships

Offered to music majors and non-music majors, these scholarships are based solely on the basis of talent. Awards range from \$500 to \$2,500 and are renewed annually as long as the student takes private lessons and performs in an appropriate large ensemble (Symphonic Band, Chamber Singers, or Choral Union).
