### **Who should take this program?**

- You want a career in the HEALTH SCIENCES (PHARMACY, OPTOMETRY, DENTAL HEALTH, PHYSICIAN ASSISTING, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY, PSYCHOLOGY or PHYSICAL THERAPY)
- You want a Bachelor of Science Degree AND a Masters or Doctor Degree in the HEALTH SCIENCES at Pacific University
- You want a B.S. program designed to help you succeed in graduate school

### **Why is this program special?**

### **What is the requirement to join this program?**

- TOEFL iBT 79 (paper TOEFL 550)
- High school diploma with at least 3.0 GPA
- First, apply only for regular undergraduate admission
- After one semester, apply to ADVANTAGE PROGRAM (Pacific cumulative GPA of 3.2 +)
- If no TOEFL, begin with our ELI TRANSITION PROGRAM (above), join the ADVANTAGE program later
