The Humanities include courses in English, History, Media Arts, Philosophy, and World Languages and Literatures. While these departments have their own goals and specialized programs, they are united in a common endeavor to discover and make relevant the historical direction and essence of humans' cultural endeavors and to help students prepare for a life of quality and meaning. In this sense, the Humanities are at the heart of liberal arts education.

By special arrangement, students may pursue a self-designed course of study in the Humanities. Interested students should submit, no later than the beginning of their junior year, a written proposal with an identifiable academic focus to the Humanities Division Chair. Admission is selective and requires a 3.0 GPA. Coordinated Studies in Humanities (CSH) majors must maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 each semester to remain in the program.
