Residency Requirements / Housing Options

HOUSING: Students out of high school less than two years are **REQUIRED** to live and board on campus. However, there are four exceptions to this rule: 1. You are under 18 years old and will be under 18 years old for the whole academic year. 2. You are married or have dependent children who will live with you while you study. 3. You have been out of high school more than two years. 4. You are 21+ years old. If you match one of these 4 exceptions, you are **NOT REQUIRED** to live on campus, but you can request to live on campus if space is available. **Students with 3rd or 4th year standing, ELI students and ELI transition students are assigned rooms only if space is available.**

- I am **REQUIRED to live on campus.**
- I am **NOT REQUIRED to live on campus, but I WANT to live on campus. Please arrange a room for me, if available.**

MEAL PLAN: All students living in the residence halls are required to participate in one of the University meal plans. Note: excludes students residing in Vandervelden Court. There are some exceptions for students residing in units with kitchens in Burlingham Hall and the new residence hall.

I agree that the University may terminate this agreement and take possession of the room or space at any time for violation of this agreement, University rules and regulations, or for reasons of health or safety. In the event that this becomes necessary for disciplinary reasons, I understand that I will still be held responsible for the full cost of the entire contract period. I certify that I have supplied complete and correct information. I understand that any change in my status or eligibility must be reported to the Student Life Housing Office immediately. I further understand that the housing check-in dates/times will be mailed to me with my housing assignment and I can also access check-in information from the housing web pages. **Unsigned applications will NOT be processed.**
