

Advanced Ocular Therapeutics Labs (AOT #7) – August 16-17, 2008
Sponsored by the Optometric Physicians of Washington (OPW)
Pacific University College of Optometry -- Jefferson Hall

DPA & TPA certification is required prior to being certified for orals and injectables (epinephrine) in Washington State.

To prescribe drugs administered orally for diagnostic or therapeutic purposes in Washington State:

- **A minimum of 16 hours of didactic instruction is required.**
Oregon's Didactic Course meets this requirement (a registration form is enclosed).
- **8 hours of supervised clinical instruction is required.**

Persons administering epinephrine by injection for anaphylactic shock must have:

- **4 hours of didactic and supervised clinical instruction.**

8 Hour Supervised Clinical Instruction (sponsored by OPW):

Saturday, August 16, 2008 – 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m./Breakfast & lunch will be provided.
Completed registration form must be mailed with payment to OPW. This course is required for Washington State certification at the highest level.

4 Hour Injection Lab (sponsored by OPW):

Sunday, August 17, 2008 – 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon/Breakfast will be provided.
Completed registration form must be mailed with payment to OPW. This course is required for Washington State certification at the highest level.

23 Hour Didactic Course (sponsored by the Oregon Optometric Physicians Association): ***Completed registration form must be mailed with payment to OOPA*** (we have enclosed a registration form for your convenience). This course qualifies for certification at the highest level in Washington State for the didactic portion of the requirements.

1 Hour Supplement Plus Exam (sponsored by OPW):

Saturday, August 16, 2008 – 4:30 p.m. until 5:30 p.m. Exam to follow.
Completed registration form must be mailed with payment to OPW. If you took Oregon's didactic course prior to September 2006 you must take this one hour supplement to qualify for certification for the didactic portion of the requirements in Washington State. Washington State does NOT accept the Treatment & Management of Ocular Disease (TMOD) examination in lieu of the didactic instruction. There will be a test following the supplement.

7 Hour Injection Lab (sponsored by the OOPA):

Completed registration form must be mailed with payment to OOPA. This lab qualifies for certification in Washington State for the injection portion of the requirements. If you would like certification in BOTH Washington & Oregon take this 7 hour injection lab.
