• How do I initiate veterans benefits?

You should apply for veterans education benefits directly through the Department of Veterans Affairs. The GI Bill is available to eligible veterans, as well as to eligible dependents and spouses of veterans. Visit the <u>Veterans Online Application website</u> to apply for these benefits.

You can also call the VA Education Hotline/Call Center at 1-888-GI-BILL-1 (1-888-442-4551) to inquire about education benefits. If you are approved for the GI Bill, the VA will send you a certificate of eligibility (COE) award letter.
