Support your student at the Festival Concert. Tickets will be available at the door: \$8.00 (adults) and \$6.00 (students/seniors).

Final Concert

The final concert is at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 25 at Pacific University in the Stoller Center. Tickets are \$8 (adults) and \$6 (students/seniors) and are available in the Music in May office or at the door. Students are released at the end of the concert. Recordings will be available. Forms can be turned in at the recording table at the final concert, or mailed to the recording agency by mid-June.

Registration

When you arrive, go directly to McCormick Hall to check in and receive your Music in May packet. Arrive early enough to check in, get settled in your room, and attend the Welcome / Orientation at 1:00pm in the Taylor-Meade Auditorium.

Housing and Meals

Housing is provided for Thursday and Friday nights only, except for those who have made reservations and paid *in advance* for Wednesday and/or Saturday night. No housing is available without advance arrangements. Meals are included from Thursday dinner through Saturday lunch, and are provided for student participants only. Students must clear their tray after each meal.

Rules

Violations of the Music in May rules may result in expulsion from the festival.

- Pacific University and *Music in May* accept no liability for students during the festival.
- You may not go beyond a two-block radius of campus unless you bring *written permission* from a parent or high school director.
- Attendance at all rehearsals is mandatory; be on time!
- You must notify your Music in May mentor if, *for any reason* you can't abide by the printed schedule.
- Curfew hours are strictly enforced.
- Don't lose your dorm key! Lost keys incur a charge of \$175.
- Don't lose your nametag / meal pass.
- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or firearms are allowed on campus. Violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from the festival.
- You must evacuate the premises if a fire alarm sounds. DO NOT tamper with the fire alarms; this is a criminal offense.
- You will be charged at replacement cost for damage to your room or its contents.
- Your conduct is expected to be above criticism! Should an incident requiring disciplinary action arise, We will notify your parents and principal, and you may be asked to leave the festival.

What to Bring

___ Your Instrument

Don't forget valve oil, cork grease, mutes, extra reeds, spare strings, etc., in case of emergency.

___ Your Music

Check twice to make sure it's all there before you leave home!

___ Folding Music Stand

(band members only)

___ A Pencil

With eraser would be nice. Put it in the envelope with your music so you're ready for the first rehearsal.

___ Clothes

For rehearsals, you will wear casual clothes. For the concert, all performers will wear white shirts / blouses and dark (black preferred) pants / skirts (no short skirts). Choir members need comfortable shoes!

___ Sleeping Bag & Pillow, Towel, Soap, Alarm Clock, Personal Items

The heat will not be on in the dorms - be sure to bring warm PJs and bedding, as nights can be cool.

___ For Fun

Frisbee, cards, etc. (Please note that skateboards and rollerblades are prohibited on campus - please do not bring them.)

___ Money

Bring only enough for your expenses on the trip to and from Pacific and for vending machine snacks. Music in May and Pacific University are not responsible for lost or stolen valuables. It's best not to bring any more than absolutely necessary, and to exercise caution with your cash and personal belongings.

___ Personal Belongings

Mark your belongings with your name - each year we have a number of lost/found items we're unable to return to the owner!
