

Institutional Contractual Agreement Financial Aid for Study Abroad

This agreement is entered into between Pacific University, Forest Grove, Oregon (the Home Institution) and

(the Host Institution) for the benefit of all students the Home Institution approves for study abroad through

As allowed in Parts 668.19, 668.39 and 668.5, Student Assistance General Provisions, and Part 690, Pell Grant Program, Code of Federal Regulations, this agreement is entered into between the institutions listed below for the purpose of providing federal financial assistance to students. This agreement will apply to Title IV funds, including Pell Grants, SEOG, Perkins Loans, Federal Work-Study, William D. Ford Direct Loans, TEACH Grants, and any other student financial aid.

Certifications by the Host Institution:

- The Host Institution certifies that it has not had its eligibility to participate in FSA Programs terminated by the United States Department of Education (the Department).
- The Host Institution certifies that it has not voluntarily withdrawn from participation in the FSA Programs under a termination, show-cause, suspension, or similar type proceeding initiated by the institution's state licensing agency, accrediting agency, guarantor, or by the Department.
- The Host Institution certifies that the Home Institution and the Host Institution are not owned or controlled by the same individual, partnership, or corporation and are otherwise unrelated.

Agreements of the Host Institution:

- The Host Institution agrees not to pay (or to cause to be paid) the student's Title IV funds or process any federal loans during the enrollment period. Further, The Host Institution agrees to notify the Home Institution in writing if the student withdraws from the program.
- The Host Institution agrees to provide (or cause to be provided) an official transcript of the student's academic record to the student upon request at the end of the program.
- The Host Institution agrees that all students will be enrolled at least full-time, and the Home Institution will be notified if enrollment drops to below full-time.

Certifications and Agreements by the Home Institution:

- The Home Institution agrees to continue the enrollment of the student(s) at the Home Institution while participating in the study abroad program. The student(s) shall be

subject to the rules and regulations of the Home Institution and Title IV financial assistance regulations, including those regulations regarding full-time student status and progress toward a degree. The students are also subject to the rules and regulations of the Host institution and any cooperating foreign universities.

- The Home Institution agrees to provide payment to the student(s), if eligible, under the programs listed above for the appropriate period of time.
- The Home Institution agrees to accept credit for the coursework provided under this agreement as per federal regulations governing Title IV student assistance programs.
- The Home Institution agrees to follow the guidelines of The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 USC 1232g).
- The Home Institution certifies that no more than 25% of any student's program of study is provided through a contractual or consortium agreement.
