URGENT CARE

Call an advice nurse for guidance

If you have a health concern but aren't sure if you need to be seen or where to go for care, call an advice nurse. Advice nurses are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. They can also help with urgent questions when your doctor's office is closed.

Urgent care—dealing with unexpected illness or injury

You may need urgent care when you are sick or injured but do not have an emergency medical condition. For example, you might need urgent care for a sore throat, earache, minor pet bite, or sprain.

When you need urgent care, call your medical office for a same-day appointment. If your medical office is closed, we offer after-hours and weekend urgent care at select locations.

Emergency—care for severe symptoms that pose danger

If you have a sudden onset of severe symptoms (including severe pain) and believe your life or health is in immediate danger, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency facility.
