# Auction Agreement

## Payment

Bidder agrees to pay the total amount of their successful bid(s), in accordance with the rules concerning payments set forth below. Bids will be collected during the silent auction, live auction, special appeal and any other auctions associated with Legends.

The amount owed on all successful bids will be charged to the bidder's account for payment at the end of the auction. Payments may be made by VISA, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. Payment in full must be made the evening of the auction.

## Sales

All sales are final. There will be no exchanges, transfers or refunds, except where expressly specified. There will be no extensions of expiration dates. Refunds are not available for any unused portion(s).

## Item Usage

All certificates for items and services must be redeemed within one year of June 26, 2016, or in accordance with any other specified expiration date. Please make initial contact with any private donors within 30 days of tonight's event.

No refunds will be allowed on travel packages for canceled tickets and/or accommodations.

If upgrades or changes are made by the purchaser to the conditions described in packages, the purchaser is responsible for any resulting increased costs.

Certificates are non-negotiable for cash, credit or payment of prior accounts.

## Item Removal

All items should be removed from Waverley the night of the auction. If you are unable to remove your item, please make arrangements with Pacific University staff. If items purchased need to be shipped to a bidder's address, the university will make arrangements for shipping. The bidder is responsible for those associated costs.

## Liability

Pacific University has endeavored to describe items correctly, but all items are sold "as is." Pacific University makes no warranties or representations regarding any items and is not responsible for the correctness of description, authenticity, authorship or condition of any items. No oral or written statements at the sale or elsewhere shall be deemed to be such a warranty, representation or assumption of liability.
